### Studio Lighting (PH227, 3 credits)

#### Course Description:

Studio Lighting is a lecture-demonstration course for the serious photographer who has a firm grasp of basic black-and-white photographic skills. This course includes the use of tungsten and electronic flash illumination for portraiture, still life, and interior photography.

*Prerequisite: Photo I*

Students will:

1. Create a proper(desired) exposure using a variety of lighting sources. (PC 1, 2)
2. Demonstrate ability to use mixed light sources. (PC 1, 2)
3. Emulate images from the industry. (PC 1,2,5)
